Applications are inviting for PhD Programme in following Departments:

- (i) Commerce & Management
- (ii) Computer Science and Engineering
- (iii) Applied Sciences (Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics, English)
- (iv) Agriculture (Vegetable Science)
- (v) Journalism & Mass Communication

Eligibility Criteria:

The PhD admission will be followed as per the minimal eligibility criteria of the UGC regulation -2022 for PhD admission.

Or

Master Degree in Management/Computer Science and Engineering /Applied Science (Physics/ Chemistry Math/ English), Pharmacy or any other relevant to above discipline with a minimum 55% marks (CGPA 6.0 on a 10 – point scale) equivalent. A 5% relaxation in score for SC/ST/OBC i.e. minimum of 50% or equivalent CGPA is allowed.

Note: The NET/JRF candidates are exempted from Written Examination.

1. The Entrance Test will be conducted in online mode at United University Campus, Prayagraj only.

2. Level -1 will be Written Test consist of two parts. Part - I will have 50 objective type questions of 2 marks each from Research Methodology and Part-2 consist 50 objective type questions forms subject specific. There shall not be any negative marking. The total marks of both papers will be 200. The duration of entrance exam will be 120 minutes.

3. Level -2 Test shall entail an interview and may include Presentations, Group Discussions or other mode of appraisal and shall be administered by the Doctoral Research Committee of the Department concerned.

4. A candidate who fails to secure the minimum qualifying marks as per the University norms in Level-1 shall stand disqualified for Level-2.

5. In accordance with the University norm, 70% of weightage will be given to the written examination and 30% to the interview.

6. The University shall not provide any scholarship or financial benefit to the Research Scholar.
