

CELEBRATING BRILLIANCE AND CREATIVITY AT 2023-24







Bridging urban and agricultural communities











Uniting against climate change










stepped up as country heads. Leading the charge was Haseeb Khan, serving dutifully as the President of the committee.







ENHANCING DIGITAL CAPABILITIES






